world.



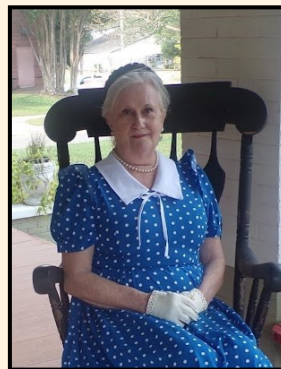
**Pat Chase**
