aliened conveyed and Released and do  
by their presents grant bargain sell  
alien convey and release unto Martin Dowdy  
his heirs and assigns forever all my Rights  
Title Claim and interest in the following  
described Negroes belonging to the Estate of  
William Hulet deceased the said interest  
being one sixth or such his part as the  
widow & child of the said deceased  
I to wit a negro woman Jane By Low  
& Girl Dice all slaves for life for and  
in consideration of the sum of two  
hundred dollars to me in hand  
paid the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged hereby binding myself  
to warrant and forever defend the  
title to my interest in the said  
Negro Jane Low & Dice against  
the claim or claims of any & all persons

whatsover claiming the same under the  
 said cloudy his being assigned legal Represen-  
 tations for ever in testimony whereof I have  
 sign My name and affix my seal & have  
 of Seal at Tarrant this the 4 Day of June 1858
