Know all men by these presents that I Green W Crowder of the County of Hopkins in the State of Texas for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas J Rogers of the County of Titus in said State of Texas have bargained sold and conveyed unto the said Thomas J Rogers his heirs and assigns forever the following and described Negro slaves to wit one Negro woman named Nancy about about thirty three years old of yellow complexion one Negro girl named Sarah about ten years old of yellow complexion one Negro boy named Alexander alias Elliot about seven years of yellow complexion and one Negro girl child about eight months old of yellow complexion the right and title to said Negroes I bind myself my heirs and legal representatives to warrant and forever defend against all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same on any point thereof save the help in Court for the following use and to wit viz that whereas the said Green W Crowder is justly indebted to the following named Persons as follows viz to Messrs R Pitkin & Co the sum of one hundred ~~thirty~~ <sup>two</sup> dollars due by promissory Note dated New Orleans March the 27<sup>th</sup> 1854 to Messrs R Pitkins & Co the sum of six hundred and forty nine ~~and~~ <sup>two</sup> dollars due by promissory Note dated New Orleans July 12<sup>th</sup> 1854 to Messrs J B Palmer & Co the sum of five hundred and seventy seven dollars <sup>and</sup> ~~two~~ <sup>two</sup> dollars due by Note date 1<sup>st</sup> June 1855 to Order of Bull & Co the sum of one hundred and twenty nine <sup>and</sup> ~~two~~ <sup>two</sup> dollars due by Note dated July the 14<sup>th</sup> 1854 and due the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 1855 to Messrs J B Palmer & Co the sum of five hundred and twenty ~~two~~ <sup>two</sup> dollars dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1855 due as aforesaid by promissory Note and being described to secure the payment of said several debts and for the further consideration that the said parties first named the collection of the same ten months from the date of these presents Now if the said Green W Crowder shall well and truly pay off the aforesaid several debts due as aforesaid by promissory Note by the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September A D 1857 then and in that case this deed to become null and of no effect but in the event the said Green W Crowder shall fail to pay off and discharge the said several promissory notes
