jamin Clark, James E. Hopkins, Rebecca Hopkins, Mrs S. Johnston, Sabirah John-
ston Mary Stephenson Jacob Gregg Cinderella Gregg (the wife of Sam Gregg Dec^d)
Heirs at Law of John Gregg Deceased, for and in consideration of the sum of
Three Hundred and Twenty Dollars paid us by Josiah Gregg the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by the presents do bargain
sell deed and convey all of our right to Josiah Gregg of Hopkins County and
State and aforesaid Three Hundred and Twenty acres of land granted to John Gregg, af-
foresaid of James Bankhead, the same being situated in Hopkins Co. State of Texas, Beginning
at a stake at McLeond's N. E. corner from which a Red Oak bears N 70 W 9 varas
an oil. 1/4. N 30 W 6 varas. Thence N crop South Sulfur 1188 varas North
in all 1343 varas to a stake from which a Burr Oak bears S 60 W 11 varas a Red Oak
be S 55 West 8 varas. Thence West 262 varas South Sulfur in all 1343 varas to an
elm marked 2 Blazes a Burr Oak be N 80 E 2 varas an Elm be S 55 W varas
Thence South 1343 varas to the North corner of said McLeond's survey from which
