 the title to the said Slave to Sarah C. Crawford and her heirs
 & assigns forever. done in Hopkins County, Tenn
 this Oct. 18th 1860

 all and any person claiming under any other person
 what ever — In witness here I affix my name and
 signature acknowledge the same to be fully

State of Texas in consideration of the sum of Seven  
hundred and fifty dollars to us in hand paid  
by Eli Lindley of said State and County have  
granted bargain and sold and aliened and  
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
unto the said Eli Lindley all that certain tract  
or parcel of land described as follows: Cont. Situation  
in Hopkins County on the waters of South Tarrant  
about miles N.W. from Fort Worth being part of  
a Survey of 640 acres Surveyed for Jonathan Lindley  
by virtue of Certificate No. - issued by the Comm.  
issuers of the National Road on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July  
1845 to Mr. J. Sims for 640 acres Beginning at  
the South East corner of said Survey of 640 acres  
Runs North one hundred and fifty poles or thereabouts  
thence the North East corner of said original 640  
acre Survey. Thence West one hundred and fifty  
poles and to the old firm now a stake in the north
